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| <b>Animals and New Life &amp; Easter</b> | We have been looking at jungle animals, farm animals, animal habitats, animals and their young. What other animals can you find out about? How many animals can you name? Can you create a picture of any of these animals in their habitats?   |
| <b>Phonics</b>                           | Can you use your phonics to practise reading and writing independently.<br><br>Don't forget your tricky words! Go to YouTube Phase 2 & 3 Tricky Words song.   |
| <b>Literacy</b>                          | Read every day, lots of different books. Talk about what you have read, draw a picture of your favourite character or event.<br><br>Keep a diary - this can be in the form of pictures, photos, captions or writing.  |
| <b>Maths</b>                             | Keep practising numbers 1-10 and 1-20, reading writing number sentences and solving problems involving addition and subtraction.<br><br>Get cooking; focus on the recipe, measuring the ingredients and the time it takes. Add the recipe and photos to your diary.<br><br>Make models using construction toy or 'junk' - be inventive! |
