3,4,5 and 6	Please keep the Green GGR exercise book at home. This is where the children record 3 reading entries per week, stick in text excerpts and respond to follow up tasks. These books will be collected in at the end of each half term for review.	Group Guided reading text (to be kept at home until finished) Text excerpts may be sent home or shared on Showbie. Free reader books can be changed at child's discretion.
