News from Alrewas and Fradley Charities....

We are delighted to announce that this community charity have agreed to provide extra funding. They have paid for a Speech and Language Screening Programme (Wellcomm) at a cost of 458.95, and a Reading Comprehension Diagnostic tool (YAR), at a cost of £303.95. This will help to assess and provide timely support as we work together to fill gaps in learning. They have also agreed to contribute £250 towards extra cleaning costs incurred due to covid 19.
