Dates for your Diary

COVID-19

Parents have been really supportive in getting children tested for COVID even when they aren't displaying all of the symptoms. It is very much appreciated and helping us all feel more safe. Just to clarify which test you should take in case you're unsure...

There are different tests you can get to check if you have coronavirus (COVID-19). The test you need depends on why you're getting tested.

The 2 main tests are:

- PCR tests – mainly **for people with symptoms**, they're sent to a lab to be checked
- Rapid lateral flow tests – can be done at home and are **only for people who do not have symptoms**, they give a result in 30 minutes. They may not give an accurate result if you already have symptoms.
