Emily Perks (349 points)

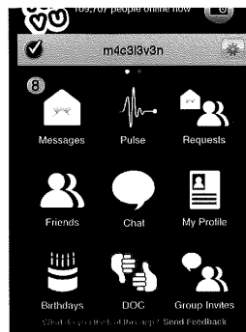


Safeguarding Issue - Social Media
