



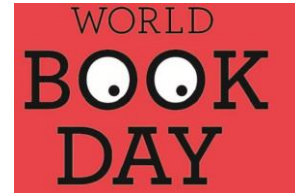

She has advised that individual parents/carers report any such incidents by phoning 101 on the day of occurrence with as much information as possible.

### Car Park

At the recent School Governors Premises Committee meeting the issue of Health & Safety in the school car park was discussed. There have been some 'near misses' when children being delivered to school in the morning and collected after school have been making their way to their cars at times too loosely supervised by their parents. Now that many children arrive before 8.30am for their extra tuition it is essential that they access school through the main entrance and not be dropped off in the car park at a busy time when staff are arriving. The decision has therefore been made that parents should not use the car park at any time for bringing children to Before and After School Club in the mornings nor when collecting them from the Club at the end of the day.

For organisations hiring the school premises the car park is available from 6.00 pm (once After School Club has finished). For other events such as parents' evenings the car park will be available after 6.00pm when all children are off the premises.

These changes have been made so that the school can always assure the safety of children arriving and leaving school. Please be aware that this arrangement will start from Monday 29 February.

We wish to thank you in anticipation of your cooperation and apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.
