An extract from the site is below...

Testing for people with symptoms

If you have any of the following symptoms of coronavirus:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

Or if you're asked to by NHS Test and Trace, you must isolate immediately, [book a coronavirus test online](#) or by ringing 119, and remain in isolation until you receive your test result.

Precautionary symptoms

It is possible to catch coronavirus and not display any symptoms. Many people who have tested positive also displayed other symptoms.

Staffordshire residents are therefore advised to book a coronavirus test as a precaution if they have symptoms such as:

- Headaches
- Aches and pains
- Feeling very tired for no good reason
- Sore throat
- Runny nose
- Sneezing
- Sometimes 'tummy ache' in children

If you have one or more of these additional symptoms, [book your test online](#) and when you are able to, select the option "My local council has asked me to get a test".
