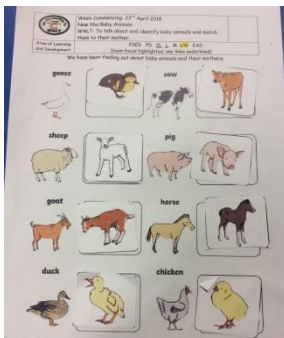
Nursery and Reception children in Bobtails are having a fantastic year. We have been having lots of fun and learning lots of new things.



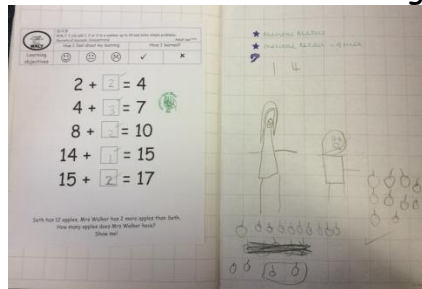
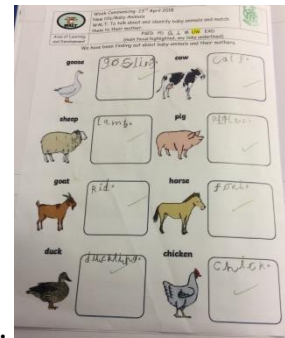
Celebrating Chinese Year. We performed a special dance. Look at our dragons!



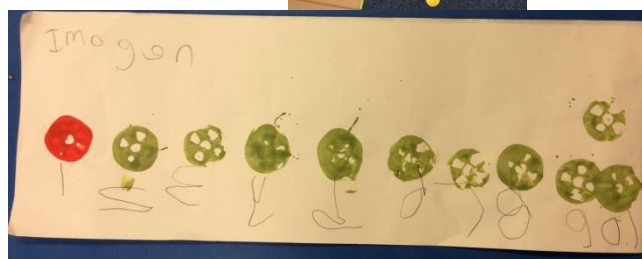
Forest School fun! We work together in our woodland area building dens and learning new skills.
