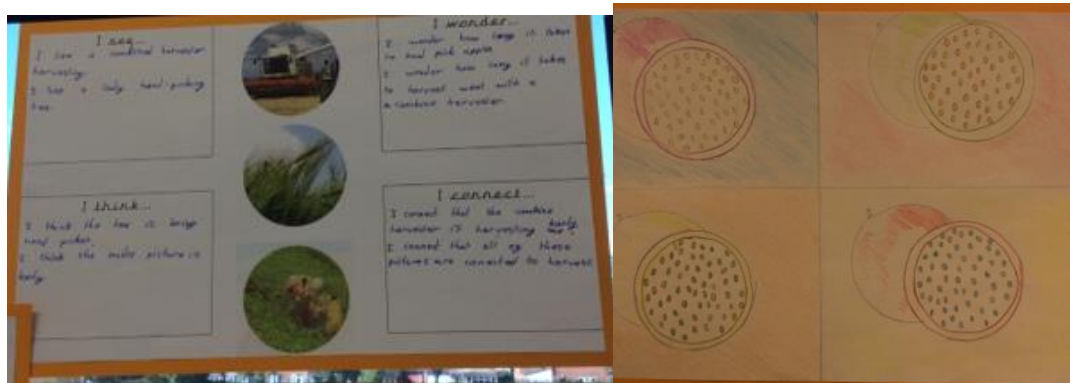
**H**arvest is about all the healthy fruit and vegetables for our family.
