Welcome Back

We are very much looking forward to welcoming children back into school tomorrow and are optimistic about getting back to 'normal'. In terms of COVID safety we will continue with hand washing, ventilation, and reduced movement around school. We will keep visitors to a minimum and will ensure that all adults in school continue with lateral flow testing. We will remain vigilant when children present with symptoms and ask that parents continue to support with PCR testing when any such symptoms occur. We are allowing children to bring bags and equipment in but ask that this be kept to a minimum – one **SMALL** pencil case (*KS2 only*) and a small bag or book-bag if necessary. Children will continue to wear PE kit to school on PE days to avoid clutter in school. This is so that we can continue to focus on rigorous cleaning and hygiene.

We will obviously continue to monitor the situation and follow government guidance and will implement changes if necessary. We will keep you fully informed.

Reading and Homework

All children will be provided with a Reading Record Book tomorrow (Reading and Phonics for EYFS & KS1). We want reading to be a big focus and the expectation is that children will read every day and record it in their new record book. Teachers will discuss this with the children tomorrow. Spellings and maths homework will continue in the usual way though we will be introducing My Maths (a homework app) in the next couple of weeks. Information will follow.
