School Arrangements Following Announcement of National Lockdown

Dear parents and carers,

We were informed late last night that additional restrictions to limit the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19) will be in place nationally from today. As such, I am writing to you to outline the arrangements for school that will come into effect from tomorrow.

Critical workers and vulnerable children

The school will be open only to those children of critical workers and vulnerable children, as defined here: <https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/coronavirus-covid-19-maintaining-educational-provision/guidance-for-schools-colleges-and-local-authorities-on-maintaining-educational-provision>

If your child is eligible to access childcare provision, please contact the school detailing your job title and employer at headteacher@allsaints-alrewas.staffs.sch.uk

It is essential that we have this information by midday today, 5th January 2021, so that we can plan provision for all children, in school and online.

Remote Learning Arrangements

Maths and English learning for the week has already been posted on Showbie and can be accessed by all children as a starting point. By the end of this week, learning will be posted that include maths, English, Phonics, spelling, reading, PE, Music, Science, Art, DT, History, Geography, Computing and PSHE. Where possible cross-curricular learning will be set that makes links across subjects.

Lessons will be provided via Zoom to compliment work on Showbie. We will let you know the timetable for Zoom lessons as soon as we know the number of children that need in- school provision.

It is important that the pupils who will be learning from home continue to complete educational tasks set by their teacher. The school understands that each family's circumstances and their access to learning material for their children differs, and the responsibility to provide educational support at home can be difficult for families. It is, however, important that pupils remain engaged in education, even when they are not attending the school site. Where the school is providing online teaching, we would encourage all pupils to attend to ensure they are not missing out on vital education. Extra support will be provided for children with SEND.

We understand that this is a very worrying time for everyone in our community and we are here to support you and your child in any way that we can.
