

Parent Forum Summary  
February 2018

Topics for discussion and action:

- Road Safety Awareness:
  - PCSO Tracy Horton to do some safety awareness training for all classes. (9<sup>th</sup> February)
  - An application has been made for a Co-op Dividend Award of £1,500 to be used to improve road safety around school. If we are successful with the bid the money will be used for cones, high visibility vests, step counters, measuring wheels (maths link), materials for car stickers, a school banner and cone placards.
  - A competition is to be set up for the children to design cone placards. Book tokens will be given as prizes.
  - Bike/scooter park: This was discussed again and it was made clear that road safety around school would have to improve before such an investment was made. Ms Golden to investigate how this has been implemented in other schools.
  
- School Dinners: We are in the process of changing our provider to Mellors. We will launch the new school dinners 1<sup>st</sup> April.
- School Values: The newly selected values were discussed and one parent suggested that 'Koinonia' (a word similar in meaning to 'community') become a feature of newsletters.
- First Aid Training: This is to be delivered to all classes in the summer term.
- Toilets: New mirrors have been purchased for the girls toilets and posters have been made.
- Homework: It was agreed that there would be clarification about expectations for homework in each year group. This will go out in the next newsletter and be added to class pages on the website.
