



SATS RESULTS 2016

2016 was the first year of the new Key Stage tests in maths, reading and grammar, punctuation and spelling. The tests assess children against a national standard. This year's tests are the first tests to reflect the new Primary Curriculum, which was introduced in September 2014. The 'levels' have gone and therefore this year's results cannot be compared to previous results.

We are above the government floor standards and are extremely pleased with our results:
