Next Steps for academic year 2016-2017 :

- Promote sustainability within the team. Expand PE team to ensure lasting legacy sharing of skills/ experience.

- Establish 'Wake Up, Shake Up' Club and 'KS1 Change 4 Life' club to promote non- competitive sports and healthy living.
- Introduce Innovative sports (Tri-Golf, Fencing, Boccia). Possible investment in equipment.
