



# All Saints' (CE) C Primary School

## **Key findings – Pupil Voice**

*The following information is based on a series of questions presented to all year 2 – 6 children to gain an insight into their opinions regarding mathematics during the lockdown period and start to the Autumn term, academic year 2020-21. The survey was completed on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October.*

**79%** of KS2 children enjoy their maths lessons.

**97%** of KS2 children feel challenged, all of UKS2 children feel that they are consistently challenged in maths.

**All** KS2 indicated they complete reasoning and problem- solving challenges daily thus indicating varied lesson content.

**99%** of KS2 children agree that maths is important.

**All** children in KS2 agree or strongly agree that their teacher explains things clearly in maths.

**88%** of children agree or strongly agree that they are clear on their next steps and what their targets are in maths.

**98%** of KS2 have indicated that they are set and complete regular (weekly) homework activities.

Almost all the children believe that they show independence in maths (**99%**) since they are aware of where to access support resources in the class to support their understanding/ learning.

### ***Home learning during COVID pandemic:***

**86%** of KS2 children agreed or strongly agreed that home learning tasks were clearly outlined and straight forward to follow during lockdown.

**95%** of children knew where they could go to access support during home learning activities.
